



Grab hold of the control panel from the top and the bottom. Squeeze the the panel and pull it toward you. The Panel is held by a two stage clip for the bottom and the top. The first-time removal may be tougher and require a bit more force.



You can brace your thumb against the outer frame. However do not press down on the front of the panel or pry the sides of the panel as this may result in damaging the control panel or breaking the clips that hold it.



Once the first clip is released, the rest should let go with ease.



To re-install the control panel, align the connector with the outlet slot. The connector needs to be installed perfectly in line with the outlet. Do not use force when aligning the connector with the outlet.



Once the connector is in line with the outlet, you can proceed to secure the control panel by gently pressing the edges or corners until the clips engage.



Under no circumstances, are you to press the centre of the control panel. This may cause permanent damage to the control panel.



During removal or installation do not press the button on the side of the control panel. The power should be cut off from the thermostat prior to removal or installation of the control panel.
